## Your Itinerary

**DAY THREE** National Baseball Hall of Fame Day! Following breakfast, the group will be welcomed by Hall of Fame staff and taken for a private Artifact Spotlight for a hands-on baseball experience. Afterwards the group will tour the Hall of Fame. The afternoon and evening will be at leisure to explore all Cooperstown has to offer.

**DAY FOUR** Following breakfast, the group will travel to Boston for the final leg of the tour. Upon checking into Hotel Commonwealth, the afternoon will be at leisure before watching the Boston Red Sox play.

**DAY FIVE** Following breakfast, the day starts with a private tour of historic Fenway Park. Lunch will be provided. In the afternoon the group will travel to Harvard Yard to tour the area and learn about Harvard's impact on sports. An evening farewell dinner will wrap up the tour and offer the group time for camaraderie.
